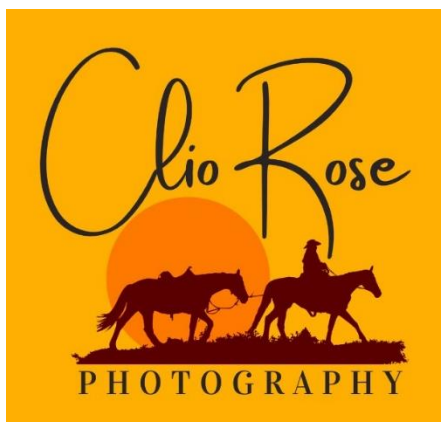

Show Information

Entries: Full payment (excluding Clean Stall Deposit if applicable) must be included with entry along with a signed Waiver Form and a copy of your HCBC number.

Entries can be sent:

- via email to NVIH>ShowEntries@gmail.com along with an E-Transfer, OR
- dropped off at Evolution Equestrian at 5352 N Island Hwy Unit C, Courtenay along with a cheque (payable to NVIHA) or cash.

Deadline is Friday, June 21st. Note due to the complexity of scheduling, this deadline will be strictly enforced.

Refunds: Exhibitors canceling after the show deadline shall forfeit their entry fees except in the case of a disability of entry. Entries will be refunded upon presentation of a doctor's or vet's certification.

Adds & Transfers: Horses entered by the closing date that wish to switch, scratch or add classes will be charged a \$5 office charge.

Stabling: Available on a limited basis. Priority will be given to exhibitors who must travel the furthest and those exhibitors that enter the earliest. Any horses staying overnight on the grounds must have a person staying on the grounds overnight as well.

Stalls \$32 per day, 6pm—6pm (e.g. 6pm Friday—6pm on Sunday is 2 days.)

Clean stall deposit of \$50 is required and refundable upon inspection. Requires a separate cheque or cash and must accompany entry. You must provide a clean stall deposit in order to receive your number.

Stall charts will be posted by Thursday at noon on June 28.

Camping: \$32 per night with or without electrical hook-ups. 6pm—6am. Every unit (tent or trailer) is chargeable. Please let us know if you have multiple units in your group or family.

Jumper Schooling Rounds: Schooling Rounds will be on grass and are available on both Saturday and Sunday. Each schooling round will be 15 minutes per rider and riders must be accompanied by a certified coach.

Rings: Jumper schooling is on the grass field, Hunter courses and Dressage are in the show arena.

Ride Times: Will be posted no later than Saturday, June 22nd.

Show Rules

The “Up Your Competition Game” clinic will be run according to the rules of Horse Council of BC. All owners, riders and trainers must be a HCBC member or member of their provincial equine association

Attire:

- Hunters: Formal show attire is required however braiding is NOT required.
- Dressage: Formal show attire is not required. Attire must be neat and clean as a sign of respect for the judge.
- Jumpers: Formal show attire is not required but attire must be neat and clean.
- ASTM/SEI approved helmets with fixed harnesses must be worn at all time while mounted.
- Competitor numbers must be visible.

Dogs: All dogs must be on leash on the show grounds. Absolutely no dogs in the schooling ring or show arenas at any time.

Lunging: Lunging (unmounted) is permitted in the warm-up arena provided there are no mounted riders in the arena at the time.

Under no circumstances is lunging be permitted in the upper-level arena.

General:

- Any exhibitor demonstrating unsafe or unsportsmanlike behavior in the opinion of management will be disqualified for the remainder of the clinic without any refund.
- The management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes depending on the number of entries received.
- Protests or objections or inquiries will be handled by the management.

Schedule

Sunday

Jumpers:

- Schooling rounds will begin at 8am and end at 3pm
- Course is on grass so the use of studs is recommended
- Coaches will be responsible for the First Aid of their rides when schooling

Dressage:

- Start time 9am
- Warm-up rides will be in the large arena
- Each rider will have a 20-minute private session which will include riding the test, getting critiqued, then riding the test again. Riders may choose to have a mini-lesson instead of riding a test.
- All tests will be held in a 20m x 60m arena
- Tests offered:
 - USDF/Equestrian Canada Introductory through Fourth Level
 - Western Dressage – HCBC, WEAA, WDAC tests
 - FEI
 - Working Equitation (WE) dressage tests – if there are enough entries for WE tests, they will be placed at the end of the day and reduce the arena to 20m x 40m
