#### **Show Information**

**Entry Deadline is Thursday, May 2nd 2024.** There is a \$25.00 late fee for all entries received after 5:00pm.

Entries can be sent to Judy Gage at NVIHAshowentries@gmail.com, <a href="maileo-horseshowtime.com">horseshowtime.com</a> or mailed to 6739 Rennie Road, Courtenay BC V9J 1V2.

Show fees can be paid by cash or cheque (please make all cheques payable to "North Vancouver Island Horse Association"). Please leave an open cheque if you expect to make changes to your entries. Separate stall deposit cheques are required if you need stabling. E-transfers will be accepted on the day of the show.

One form per rider/horse combination. All exhibitors must attach a copy of their current HCBC card.

**Scratches**: Exhibitors canceling after the show deadline shall forfeit their entry fees except in the case of a disability of entry. Entries will be refunded upon presentation of a doctor's or vet's certification.

**Adds & Transfers**: Horses entered by the closing date that wish to switch, scratch or add classes will be charged a \$5 office charge per change sheet per class, to a maximum charge of \$25 per day.

**Best Entry Form Submitted:** There will be a draw prize for all riders who send in a fully completed entry form.

**Stabling:** Available on a limited basis. Priority will be given to exhibitors who must travel the furthest and those exhibitors that enter the earliest. Any horses staying overnight on the grounds must have a person staying on the grounds overnight as well.

Stalls \$32 per day, 6pm—6pm (e.g. 6pm Thursday—6pm on Saturday is 2 days.)

Clean stall deposit of \$30 is required and refundable upon inspection. Requires a separate cheque and must accompany entry. You must provide a clean stall deposit in order to receive your number.

**Camping:** \$32 per night with or without electrical hook-ups. 6pm—6am. Every unit (tent or trailer) is chargeable. Please let us know if you have multiple units in your group or family.

**Schooling Rounds:** \$25 per schooling rounds available on Friday for Jumpers and Saturday for Hunters. Schooling rounds will be 10 minutes per rider. Please contact Dorothy Christie at <a href="mailto:islandsporthorses@gmail.com">islandsporthorses@gmail.com</a> to book schooling rounds. **Please book by Thursday, May 2nd at 5pm.**

#### **Show Rules**

The NVIHA Hunter Jumper Series competition is governed by the current HCBC Rule Book. All Classes will be judged accordingly unless otherwise stated in the Prize List.

**HCBC:** All competitors MUST be members of Horse Council BC. Please attach a copy of current membership card to entry.

**Attire:** Formal show attire is required for hunter, hacks, hunter derbies and jumper classics. Braiding is recommended for hunters and hacks. Braiding is required for Hunter Derbies. Riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets with fixed harnesses at all time while mounted. Competitor numbers must be visible.

**Points:**  $1^{st} - 7$  points,  $2^{nd} - 5$  points,  $3^{rd} - 4$  points,  $4^{th} - 3$  points,  $5^{th} - 2$  points,  $6^{th} - 1$  point

Ties for jumper championships will be broken at the discretion of the show committee. In the case of only 1 or 2 entries in a class/division, the classes/divisions will be combined and scored with another similar division.

**Ribbons:** Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded for all divisions. Ribbons will be awarded for all classes in a division from 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> place. Warmup jumper classes and Warmup Hunter classes will be judged but will not be ribboned.

Age Groups: Senior: 18 and over as of January 1st, 2024

Junior: 17 and under as of January 1st, 2024 (must have a parent's or legal guardian's

signature)

The Show Committee reserves the right to combine, alter, or cancel any classes. Championships will be awarded to divisions with three or more riders. Questions and concerns are to be addressed to the show manager. Show committee's decisions are final. Protests may be submitted in writing to the office with a \$50 deposit (as per HCBC rules).




